Rules	MNZ General Road Racing & these local Supplementary Regulations:
1. Additional entries and Class extensions on the day.	<b>Absolutely none.</b>
2. Oil leakage.	<b>Machine to be removed for repair. Second occurrence will mean disqualification.</b>
3. Machine examination 'pass' sticker.	<b>Must be attached in a visible position.</b>
4. Minimum entries.	<b>12, if under - merge with another Class or cancel.</b>
5. Maximum entries.	<b>35 per class absolute cut-off</b>
6. 'Rider off', Report to St Johns in pits	<b>Rider to undergo physical check by an approved St John Officer before continuing to compete. Bike to be rechecked by machine examiner.</b>
7 Alterations to the structure of the programme.	<b><i>The Officials reserve the right to make alterations to the structure of the programme in any case of a major incident or where changing climatic conditions may affect the safety of the competitors.</i></b>
<b>8 The Organisers invite application from entrants who wish to erect any advertising and/ or mount any promotional activity at this meeting venue. Such advertising and/ or promotional activity shall not be undertaken without obtaining permission to do from the <u>Organisers</u> in conjunction with the major sponsor for this event.</b>	

9 Supermoto machine shall elect to ride in one of the following classes, BEARS (if eligible) or Supermoto. Final eligibility decision rests with the organiser whose decision shall be final. They are banned from FIII as per MNZ rules (Appendix B Rules A & B)

10 In all classes the riding style shall be in keeping with the class you have entered.

11 Classic and Post Classic are mutually exclusive.

12 As we race on a State Highway Rules 5-8-6 and 5-8-7 apply regarding Civil Licences.

13 Practice: If you are not on the grid when your practice goes out you have to wait until your class goes out the next time.

14 Wheel Standing. The organisers acknowledge that wheel standing is an accepted part of street racing. HOWEVER, THE STEWARDS WILL PUNISH OVERLY LONG OR SUSTAINED WHEEL STANDS, PARTICULARLY ON THE FRONT STRAIGHT.

Grid positions will be allocated using known ability and recent result as a guideline.

\* NB 550 – 600 machines must decide whether they ride in this class or Formula II. The same machine cannot be entered/ridden in both classes.

451 – 600 Multi Cylinder Four Stroke

501 – 750 Twin Cylinder Four Valve Four Stroke

651 – 900 Twin Cylinder Two/Three Valve Four Stroke

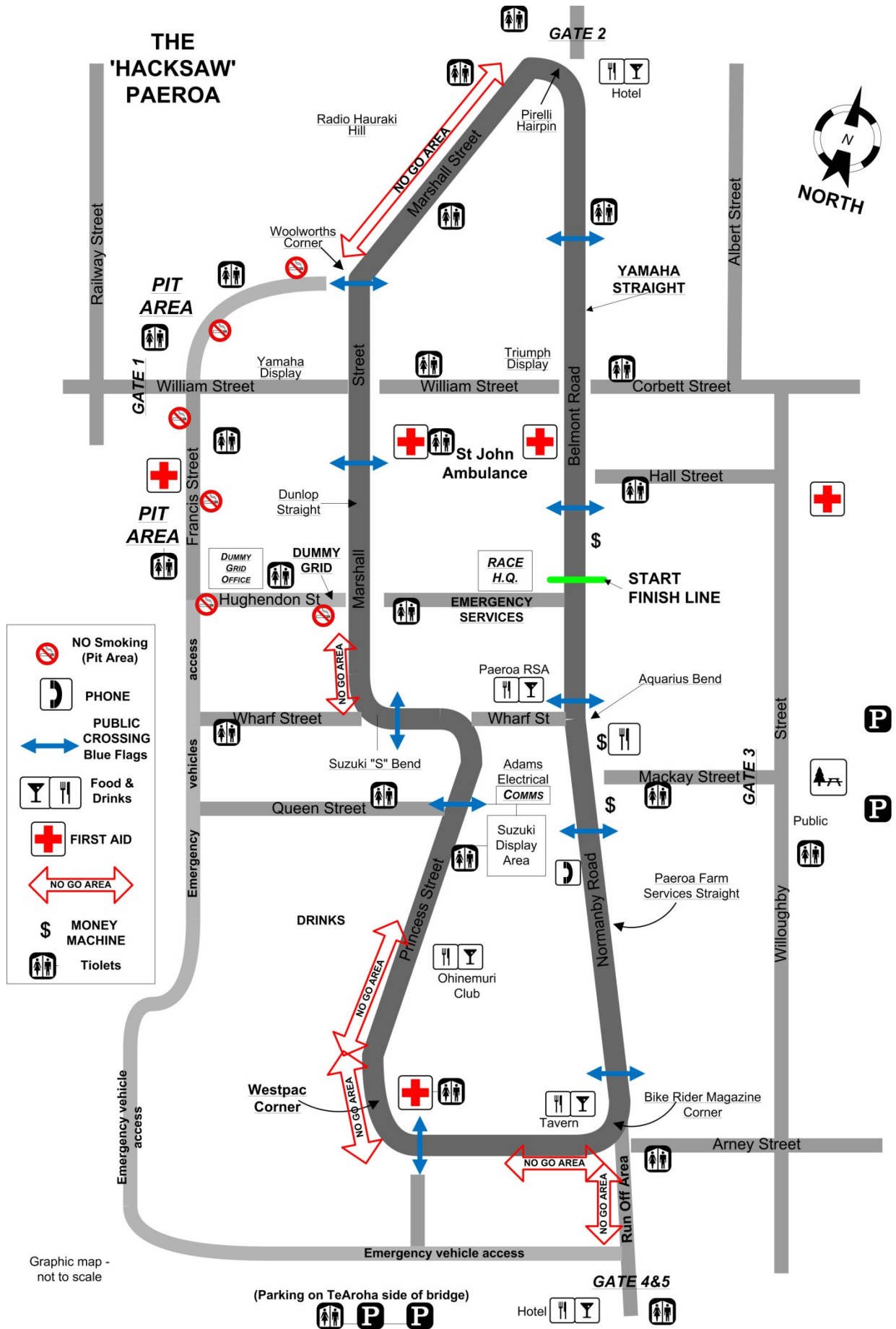
