MOTORCYCLING NEW ZEALAND COMPETITION LICENCE 2009 - 2010 SEASON

The Online option for you to apply for a Motorcycling New Zealand Licence is available to you for the 2009 – 2010 season.

For you to complete your Motorcycling New Zealand Competition Licence - **please use the unique username and password on this document.** Please ensure that you enter the details correctly.

When you log on we recommend that you change your password to suit you.

LICENCING MANUALLY

If you do not have access to internet you can still apply for your licence, by contacting your club to obtain the licence application form or alternatively contact the MNZ office. Licence applications are also available from the MNZ website www.mnz.co.nz. Please remember to allow up to 14 working days for processing. We **do not** require your log book to be sent in with your application form.

NB: If you do not complete the form correctly your application will not be accepted, and it will be returned to you for completion.

Again; this season **no confirmations** will be sent, you must have your licence to compete or you will be required to purchase a one event licence at the event (not applicable for championship, beach or street meetings).

CHANGES:

This season when you apply for a licence you will receive a new Motorcycling New Zealand Licence Card. Please sign and place into the front cover of your Log Book. Your licence card from the 2008-09 is no longer valid. When your Log Book is full please send the Log Book into the office, and a new Log Book will be issued.

You must also present your current **Club membership card when signing on at an event** – we recommend you place this under your licence card.

Racing Numbers:

Your permanent racing number will be held for you for two months; unless you gained a number in a New Zealand Championship. After two months the number will become available for any competitor.

We do not issue race numbers for the following classes:

- Mini Motocross
- Enduro
- Post Classics
- Trial
- Trail Riding
- Motard
- 150 Street Stock
- Classics

Family Discount:

The family discount is offered again; however if you would like to take advantage of the family discount you must apply for your licence manually. Remember to allow 14 working days for processing.

Redeeming One Event Licences:

If you are a first time competitor and have purchased two one event licences, you are able to receive a \$30 discount from your MNZ licence. **You must** send the two one event licences with your licence application, if you would like to take advantage of this you must apply for your licence manually. Remember to allow 14 working days for processing.

MNZ LICENCE TYPES:

Full Competition Licence

This licence allows you to compete at all types of MNZ permitted events throughout the country.

You are also able to compete in Australia with this licence, subject to receiving start permission and having appropriate insurance. For more information on this please refer to our website (www.mnz.co.nz) or contact the MNZ office.

Club Licence

The club licence is to be used at club events only. **The Club you are a financial member of and advise of on your application is the club you use this licence with.** This licence cannot be used at championship events.

You are not restricted to this licence for a complete season, if at some stage during the season of racing you decide to either compete in a Championship (New Zealand, North or South Island) event or travel to another club's event you have the opportunity to upgrade this licence.

It is preferable you upgrade the licence, by completing the appropriate form and paying the difference in fee and posting it to the MNZ office. However, there will also be an opportunity for you to complete this process at an event should the need arise.

Should you purchase a club licence, the form to upgrade to a full competition licence, will be sent to you with your licence, or is available on www.mnz.co.nz.

Associate Membership:

This is designed for those who have an interest in Motorcycling New Zealand but do not want to partake in competition or perhaps they would like to only compete in one or two Club events per year.

The benefits of this associate membership is that they have access to all of the suppliers partaking in MNZ's members benefit scheme, you have voting rights as per the constitution; and you will also receive two free one event licence's to partake in a Club event that is being held by your nominated Club.

One Event Licence:

This licence may be available for you to purchase on the day of the event. They are not available for Championship Events (New Zealand, North or South Island, or beach & street meetings). We recommend you contact the host club to ensure they do have One Event Licences available at their event as it is at the club's discretion to make them available.

Over 65 years:

If you are aged 65 years and over you are entitled to receive a free MNZ competition licence, however you will need to apply for this via postal application, rather than using the on line option.
